BOOMI HOT SPRINGS

The Hot Spa Pool has powerful overhead jets that are perfect for sore backs, underwater jets and wide full length of pool entry bench steps that allow for seating at various depths. The mineral rich hot water flows up from a depth of 1.25Km underground, at natural pressure, and arrives at ground level at 53Degrees Celsius from the Great Artesian Basin. From there it is cooled to around 39C for use in the Hot Spa. Hot Artesian water is also added to the cold pools to help reduce the shivers a little!

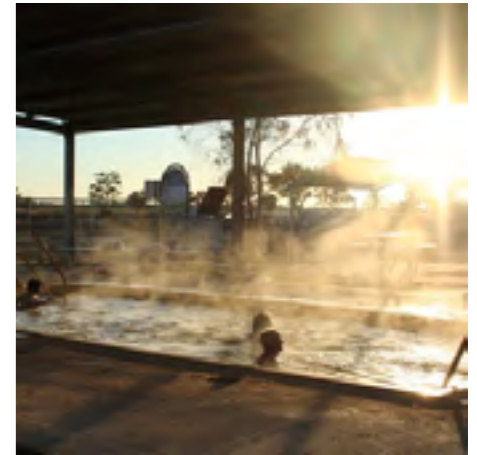

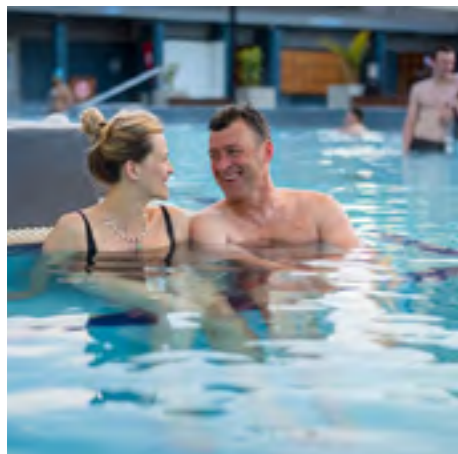
