- National Geographic Kids

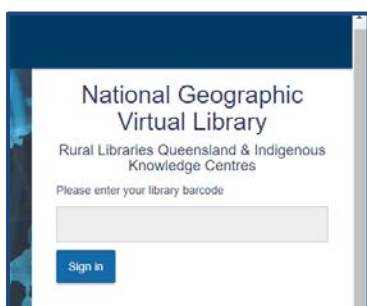
This multi-media collection is available anytime, anywhere – unlimited access.

2. Confirm you are a member of RLQ by putting in your library card number
3. Select a display language, other than English if required

### **Find**

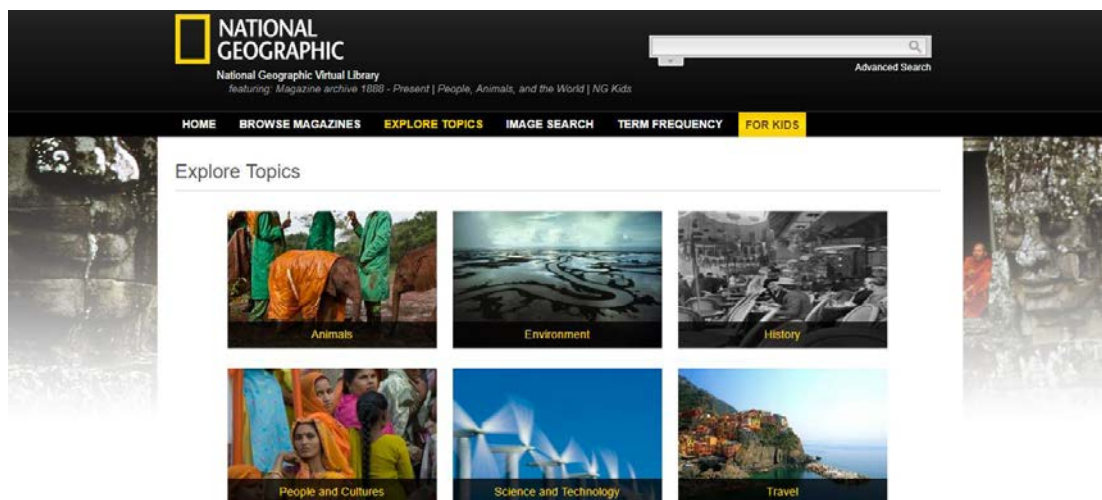
Browse magazines and read per page or search within an issue.

Chart how topics have been reported over time.



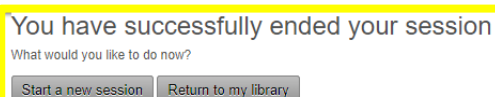
## View
