The Inglewood community is invited to attend the meeting followed by morning tea with the Councillors at 11.00am.

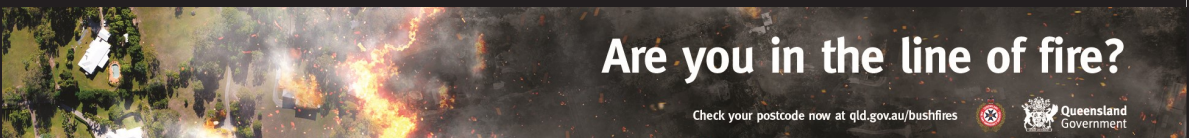

You can check for updates on road closures, river gauge heights, power outages, flood mapping, emergency contacts and any other disaster management arrangements.
