

BULK WATER FILL STATIONS – Information Sheet

- Customers will have access to bulk potable water 24 hours a day 7 days a week, thanks to the installation of water filling stations located in Goondiwindi, Texas & Inglewood.
- To ensure continued access to potable water during the drought conditions Council has installed water filling stations in West Street, Goondiwindi; Flemming St Texas, and on Brook Street side of the Lions Park, Inglewood.
- All water filling stations have user friendly instructions located on the front panel.
- The water is potable - Council gives no guarantee of the drinking water quality once collected. Council encourages residents to engage an accredited drinking water carrier for large volumes.
- Water fill stations are not intended for use by residents who have access to reticulated water or are connected to the town water supply. The water is not intended for watering gardens or stock - the water is intended for customers who don't have access to fresh clean drinking water.
- The water fill stations can facilitate vehicles of all sizes, from small passenger cars to caravans and trucks. There are two filling options – a 50mm cam lock and a 25mm thread connection. Users are required to provide their own connection and hose.
- Access to water via the new filling stations will be either through credit card transactions or a soon to be commissioned, pre-paid account card, for approved customers. Once activated, pre- paid account cards can be applied for at Council Customer Service Offices and the regular Bulk Water application process will apply.
- Pre-paid account cards are intended for approved customers who frequently rely upon bulk domestic water deliveries for fresh, clean, drinking water.
- The Credit Card transaction option is available to all other infrequent customers who do not have access to reticulated water on a town supply ie. Visitors, mobile home, caravan and motorhome customers.
- Council is committed to offering assistance to farming families, businesses and communities affected by drought through the supply of water for domestic purposes at the discounted rate
- RATES
 - ✓ Whilst in a Drought Declared Status, approved pre-paid card customers will be charged at the current, Council domestic water rate of \$1.44 per kilolitre with a minimum charge of \$5.00.
 - ✓ First time pre-paid card activation fee of \$40.00 will apply.
 - ✓ Replacement fee of \$40.00 will apply for all lost cards.
 - ✓ Credit Card paying customers will be charged at a rate of \$3.50 per kilolitre with a minimum charge of \$5.00 — No cash accepted.

✓ Please note, the machine does not dispense a manual receipt. Charges will appear on your bank statement as “Paymate* GRC Water”

- The utilisation of these units will allow Council to monitor the volumes of water dispensed.
