I wish to advise that an Exemption Certificate is granted for a development comprising the construction of a garage in a mapped flood hazard area, on Lot 2 on RP15207, 80 Donovans Road, Oman-Ama.

1. Description of the Development to which this Certificate relates

Assessable Development under the *Goondiwindi*Region Planning Scheme 2018, Part 5 Tables of Assessment

2. Reasons for Giving Exemption Certificate

The development is exempt under this Certificate under section 46(3)(b) of the *Planning Act 2016* for the following reasons:

- The effects of the development would be minor or inconsequential, considering the circumstances under which the development was categorised as assessable development.
- It is stated in the exemption request that the area to which the garage is to be built is on a high spot on the property, which hasn't been affected by floods for at least forty (40) years. Therefore, it is considered that the development is resilient to flood events and would not increase risks to personal safety.

3. When Exemption Certificate Ceases to have Effect

This Exemption Certificate has effect for two (2) years 22 July 2023.

4. State Periods that Must be Complied with

To the extent the development does not comply with any of the following, this Exemption Certificate has no effect:

The use must commence by 22 July 2023.

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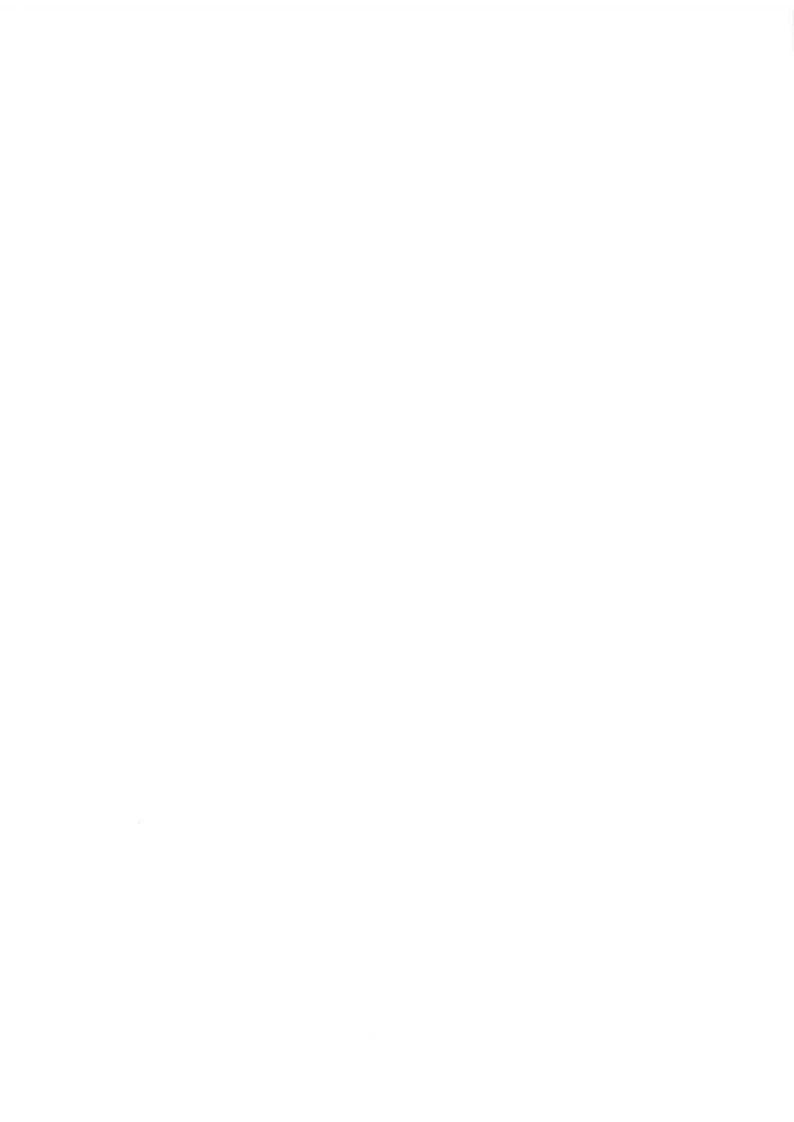
