Drinking water alert lifted in Talwood

Goondiwindi Regional Council advises all residents in Talwood that tap water used for drinking is now safe to consume.

This notice applies to all residents in Talwood from 03/02/2023.

There is no longer a public health concern over the quality of drinking water, and it is now considered safe for all typical uses including drinking, preparing food and beverages, personal washing, dishwashing, laundry purposes and flushing toilets.

Goondiwindi Regional Council has worked closely with Queensland Health over the last three weeks to resolve the situation as quickly as possible. Corrective actions have been taken to protect the safety of the drinking water. Goondiwindi Regional Council and Queensland Health will continue to closely monitor the situation.

Residents should flush out affected water from the pipes in their home. Residents are asked to share this notice with neighbours and friends.
