Is the local drinking water now safe to use?

Goondiwindi Regional Council advises all residents in Talwood that tap water is safe to consume again. There is no longer a public health concern over the quality of drinking water, and it is now considered safe for all typical uses including drinking, preparation of food and beverages, personal washing, dishwashing, laundry purposes and flushing toilets. Residents should flush out affected water from the pipes in their home.
