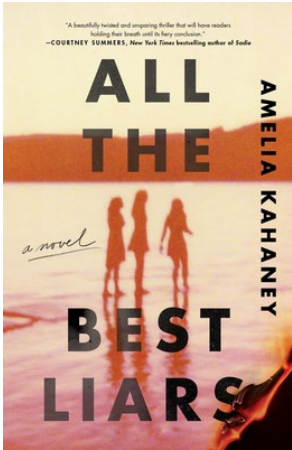
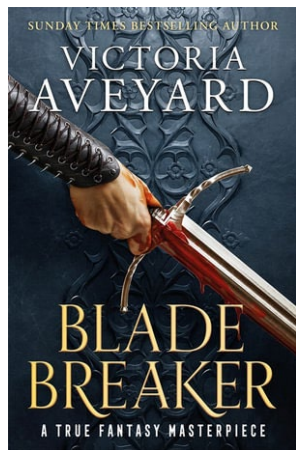


## NEW BOOKS FOR YOUNG ADULTS



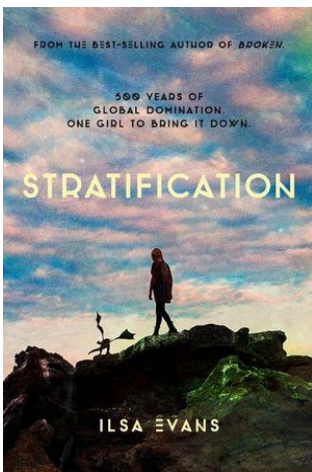
### ***All The Best Liars* / Amelia Kahaney**

### ***Blade Breaker* / Victoria Aveyard**

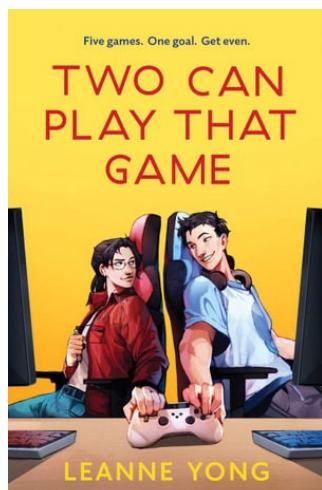
