How do I participate in the Program?

- Register with one of the above area coordinators;
- Notify all adjoining neighbours with 72 hours prior to baiting (neighbours include owners/occupiers (including QPWS) of land bordering, connecting or facing, land being baited);
- > Bring lot/plan description (Rates/Valuation Notice) of property to be baited;
- Persons collecting baits for others must have completed an 'Authority to Sign Form' signed by the property owner, including lot/plan description of parcels to be baited;
- > Baiting material must be fresh drained meat/hearts/liver; and
- > Bait size needs to be minimum 125g for Wild Dogs and 500g for Feral Pigs;
- > Baiting material must be free of bone, and skin;
- Bring a leak proof container for transporting the baits. The State Government no longer supplies plastic bags for 1080 baits.
