Replacement of lost registration tag

Should a registration tag be lost or destroyed, a replacement tag can be issued by visiting any of Council's Service Centres and making payment of the relevant fee.

Advice to dog owners

1. All dogs must be registered with the Goondiwindi Regional Council at three (3) months of age.
2. Dog owners on rural properties should give their Local Service Centre a call to find out if they qualify for exemption under the *Animal Management (Cats and Dogs) Act 2008*.
3. New residents to Goondiwindi Regional Council are required to register their dog/s within fourteen (14) days of arrival.
4. A maximum of two (2) dogs over the age of three (3) months can be kept on an allotment in a designated town area.
5. A maximum of one (1) dog is allowed to be kept at a flat or unit.
6. A dog must wear its registration tag at all times.
7. If a dog is impounded while wandering at large it is held at an impounding facility for three (3) clear working days if unregistered and five (5) days if registered.
8. All dogs are required to be implanted with a microchip before it is twelve (12) weeks old. New registrations of dogs that are not microchipped will be accepted and **owners will be given a period of fourteen (14) days to microchip their dogs.** **Breeder Identification Number will be required before implanting microchip.

Please Note *

With the introduction of the *Animal Management (Cats and Dogs) Act 2008*, all dogs are required to be registered at three (3) months of age.

Registered owners must be eighteen (18) years of age or over.

Rebate Conditions

Pensioners – To be entitled to the pensioner fee, the pensioner must hold a current Pension Concession Card (Old Age, Disability Support, Supporting Parent, or Veterans Affairs Gold Card). This must be produced each time the registration fee is paid.

Desexing – To be entitled to a desexed rebate, proof of desexing must be provided.

IF MAILING THIS APPLICATION FORM, A COPY OF THE RELEVANT CERTIFICATES MUST BE ATTACHED TO THE APPLICATION FORM.

Renewal Notices and Cancellation of Registration

A renewal notice is sent out at the beginning of each calendar year. If ownership of the dog/s change during the year, the dog/s die/s, or the dog/s no longer resides in the Goondiwindi Regional Council area, please contact the Customer Service Centre on (07) 4671 7400 or a Goondiwindi Regional Council Service Centre to update the registration details to avoid future renewal notices.

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE OWNER OF A DOG TO ENSURE IT IS REGISTERED AT ALL TIMES.

**New Puppy Breeding Legislation commenced on 26/05/2017. Anyone who has a bitch and pups must register within 1 month of pups being born. It is an offence to give pups away, either by sale or gift.
