THINGS THAT GO IN YOUR YELLOW BIN

- Plastic codes PETE 1, HDPE 2, PVC 3 and PP 5
- Newspaper
- Cartons
- Phone books
- All envelopes
- Magazines
- Junk mail (remove plastic wrap)
- Toilet paper rolls
- Laundry detergent boxes
- Shampoo bottles
- Egg cartons
- Soft drink bottles & cans
- Spirit bottles
- Flattened cardboard (including pizza boxes)
- Aluminium cans
- Steel cans
- Empty aerosol cans
- Clear, brown & green glass
- Aluminium foil (no food scraps)
- Beer bottles
- Milk cartons & bottles
- Yoghurt containers
- Cereal boxes



TIPS FOR RECYCLING

- Collected fortnightly (same day as general waste)
- Flatten cardboard boxes
- Rinse food scraps off all recycling
- Remove all lids and place in general waste bin
- Place items loose in bin not in bags
- Labels on bottles and containers don't need to be removed

THINGS THAT GO IN YOUR RED BIN

- Disposable nappies
- Food waste
- Shoes/ clothing
- String/ twine
- Cigarette butts
- Kitty Litter
- Cling wrap
- Plastic bags
- Toothpaste tubes
- Chip packets
- Take-away containers
- Coffee pods
- Polystyrene (PS 6)
- Shredded paper
- Plastic bags
- Take-away coffee cups
- Baby food pouches
- Treated pine
- Laminated paper
- Meat trays
- Bubble wrap
- Pens and pencils
- Photos
- Wine corks
- Soft plastics (LDPE4)
- Bioplastics and compostable packaging



HOW TO PUT YOUR BIN OUT

- Place bin close to kerb
- Be at least 50cm apart
- Handles are facing property to ensure council logo on bin is facing the street
- Be out by 6.00am on day of collection
- Not be overfilled – lids must fully close
- Not be overweight – less than 70kg
- Be placed clear of cars, trees and all other obstacles
