

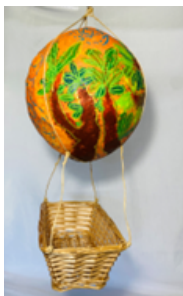

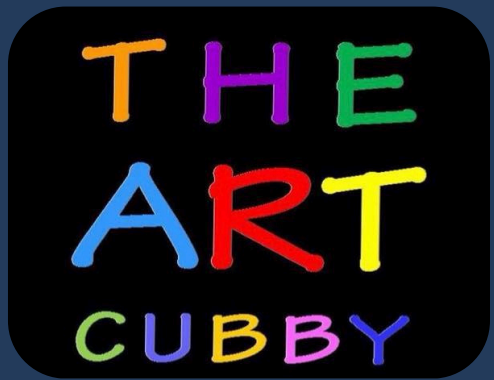

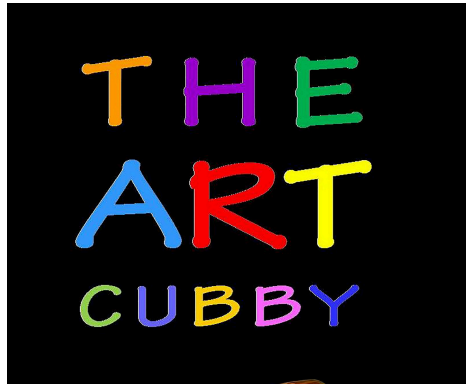

Carolyn Ferguson dedicates her life to nurturing creativity and encouraging visual artists of all ages through teaching art from her inspiring studio, The Art Cubby, in Goondiwindi.

Motivated by her desire for country kids to have access to the same artistic opportunities that shaped her, Carolyn began privately teaching in 2004. Over the past 20 years, she has instilled in her students the values of self-worth, positivity and inner strength, encouraging students to immerse themselves in playful artistic expression within a diverse and inclusive group environment. Her unwavering passion for teaching was recognised when she was awarded the South-West Queensland Cultural Champion for 2020, a testament to her positive impact on her rural community.

She finds comfort in creating art and considers it a powerful tool for resilience and self-awareness and believes that access to the arts is vital for young minds to enhance their overall emotional well-being and pro-social behaviour. She is currently deepening and developing her artistic knowledge through studying a Bachelor of Education majoring in Visual Arts and hopes to inspire many more students in the future.

Project Descriptions:

Appropriated Record Covers

This project provides meaningful exploration of music history, allowing students to reflect on how music was recorded onto Compact Disks and Vinyl Records. Students chose their favourite song and corresponding album cover and discussed how appropriation can be used in art by adapting, modifying and drawing inspiration from the original design elements to create a personalised image.

Collage Fruit Canvas

Beginning with a visit to the supermarket, students selected their preferred fruits for artistic creation. Using magnifying glass and light boxes, they observed the intricate details of the cross section of fruits to paint with greater precision. The project emphasizes the knowledge of complementary colour schemes and the application of painted papers as background collage materials.

Mandala Clocks

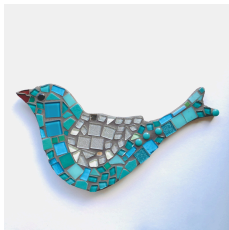
The clock project incorporates artistic expression with mathematical concepts. Students designed radial compositions that incorporate elements of texture, pattern, and repetition. By applying a piped layer of impasto gel and gold spray paint, they add a tactile quality to their clocks while integrating personal symbolism.

Dictionary Antiqued Drawings

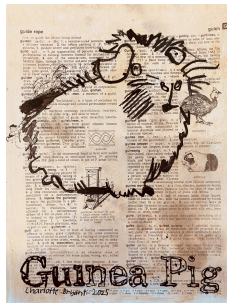
To begin, students created the illusion of antique treasure maps with a distressed patina overlaid on the dictionary page. Then they explored alternate drawing implements of feathers, sticks and toothbrushes to apply the Indian ink. We investigated typography of fonts, line, proportion and value.

Mosaics

Engaging in Mosaics allows students to develop hand eye coordination, spatial awareness, and perseverance. The selecting of selecting tiles to include a variety of shapes, colours and sizes encourages problem-solving skills through reflection and percolation. The art of Mosaics allows expression of elements and principles of design by strengthening colour theory knowledge while applying pattern, unity, variety, texture and balance.
